



Coaching- length of tenure

All applications are judged on their own merit. Our objective is to appoint quality coaches that are suitably matched to a team. Consideration will be given to the applicant's knowledge, experience and personality in relation to the age group they are applying for. For example a person who has coached successfully at senior level may have the appropriate football knowledge and experience but may not have the personality and patience required to coach under 9's or 11's. An applicant does not have to have a child of their own either playing at the club or in the team they are applying to coach for.

All appointed Coaches will be required to be CoachAFL accredited and have a working with children check prior to commencement. <https://www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au/>

Tenure:

All Coaches are appointed for a one (1) season tenure to offer players varied opportunities and experiences, game plans, and training drills . Commencing from date of appointment and terminating on the completion of the Season's Presentation Day. All Coaches positions are then deemed to be vacant and applications will be sought from both existing coaches and new people for the following season. It is the clubs intention to introduce each team to a different coach approximately every 2—3 years, although our ability to do this will depend on the caliber of applicants received. (Where a coach is willing to continue beyond the tenure above and no other individuals have expressed an interest to take over a decision regarding an appointment will be made through consultation between the committee (Junior President and Coaching Director) and parents of the playing group).

Dismissal:

The Club reserves the right to dismiss a coach without prior notice if the Executive Committee feels justified in doing so.
